Event #1 Team Skate

Open to CanSkate Plus, Adults, Teens, and all STAR skaters.

Competitors will be divided into three teams with members with a mix of all levels making up the teams. Each element skated will be awarded 1, 2, or 3 points. The team with the LOWEST TOTAL mark will be the top team. Elements to be skated will be decided by the coaching staff.

Event #2 Longest Shoot the Duck Competitors will be divided according to session level.

Event #3 Longest Spiral Competitors will be divided according to session level.



Event #4 Most Jumps Completed in Combination Competitors will be divided according to session level.

- a) Most revolutions
 Competitors will be divided according to session level.
- b) Most positions
 Competitors will be divided according to session level.

Event #7 Mystery Interpretive Competition

What is a Mystery interpretive Competition?

For a mystery interpretive competition a piece of music, approximately one minute in length, is selected for each group of skaters. The music is kept secret until the time of the competition. At the time of the competition, after a short practice during which the music will be played once, each skater will perform a solo to the music. The Skaters will be judged on how well they can improvise and interpret the music without any lengthy practice and not on the difficulty of the elements or movements the skaters use in the performance.

Event #8 Performance.

This is not a judged event, but rather an opportunity to perform a program to music of your choice. Example - free skate solo.



Please Note:

The Board reserves the right to:

- 1. Cancel events if there are insufficient competitors.
- 2. Cancel events if there is insufficient time.
- 3. Group skaters by age where appropriate.
- 4. Combine or separate events depending on numbers.



Longest Shoot the duck. - Time will start once the skater's skating leg is at 90 degrees or more. Time will stop if they put a hand down or kick the ice with their heel. They do not need to get back up. They can hold the position until they fall over. If no skaters meet these requirements the best position held the longest will be the decision maker for placement.

Longest Spiral - Time will start once the skater's skating leg is at hip level or higher. Time will stop if they put a hand down or their leg drops below the hip. They can hold the position until they fall over. If no skaters meet these requirements the best position held the longest will be the decision maker for placement.

Most Jumps Completed in combination -Can Skate plus - waltz jumps. Junior STAR Skaters - Toe Loops Intermediate STAR Skaters - Loops Seniors STAR Skaters - Loops



No steps in between jumps, no jump sequences.

Spins, Most revolutions - Any spin of any kind. No change of foot. As long as they are spinning it will count. May do one position on the one-foot spin. No more than 2 positions total.

For example - sit spin to one foot, on the same foot.

Spins, Most positions - Any spin of any kind or a variation of basic spins. May change foot only once. Skates must do at least one full rotation

in a position for it to count. The position done on the other foot will count as a different position.

Example - Sit change sit = two positions.

Solo dance - may do intro and exit posing but not mandatory. One round/lap of each dance.
