MUSIC USE

1. The skater who is performing a program or pattern to music, has the **right of way** over all other skaters and coaches.
2. Coaches may use the iPod and other devices to play music. Coaches have **priority** to play music for their skaters who are in a lesson with them at the time that they need it.
3. Skaters may access the club iPod to play solos and dances. Skaters can play this music on a first come first served basis.
4. Do not use your own device to play music. Constant changing of the cord damages the cord and iPod.
5. Headphones worn by skaters are **NOT** permitted on the ice at any time. They are a safety risk.
6. Please do not bring your cell phone to the rink. If you must bring it, leave it with your parent or place them in the score keeper's area located rink side where the music is plugged in. Do not leave it in the dressing room.
7. Do not put your phone in the plastic holder that is attached to the boards. The club is not responsible if your phone falls off the boards and is damaged.
